Board Meeting Minutes
Capital Area Housing Association (CAHA)
Held at Lucky Gardens Restaurant, Hallowell
December 2, 2014

Past-President & Treasurer Ratna Don opened the meeting at 5:46 p.m. with the following present:

Secretary & Board Member Barbara A. Eckhardt Board Member Charles Anderson Board Member John McNaughton Board Member Ramona Venskus Board Member Harrison Wolfington

Business: Motion was made by Charlie, and seconded by John, to accept the October 20, 2014 Board minutes with the following change: To delete Board Member Charles Anderson's name to Board Member John McNaughton's name. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion was made by Barbara, and seconded by Ramona, to accept the October 14 through December 2, 2014 Treasurer's report. Motion passed unanimously.

Legislative Committee: The Board discussed the CMOMA legislative committee contract. Motion was made by John for CAHA to pay \$934.50 to CMOMA for the period of one year for legislative expenses, signing no contract with CMOMA. Instead a memo will be included with the check stating CAHA's Board of Directors voted to remit a check to CMOMA to cover its 267 members at \$3.50 per member for the first year. Motion was seconded by Ramona. Motion passed unanimously.

At this point, John McNaughton left the meeting and Charlie Anderson arrived at the meeting.

Audit of CAHA Books: It was the consensus of the Board to have Barbara audit the Treasurer's books and accounts.

Annual Banquet: Ramona reported that the date for the annual banquet was all set with the Elks Club. The menu would be as last year, baked meat lasagna and baked haddock.

The Board discussed the expenses of last year's banquet and the possibility of higher food prices this year. It was the consensus of the Board to charge each member \$10.00 for their meal and \$15.00 for the first guest's meal and \$25 for additional guests.

Speaker for the Banquet: Barbara volunteered to look into the prospect of an entertainer for the banquet.

December Newsletter: Ratna requested that each Board member bring their suggestions for articles to be placed in the January newsletter.

2015 Energy Committee/Continuing Oil Contracts: It has been noted that Fielding's has not submitted an admin check to the CAHA Treasurer. Charlie states he has talked with the proper people in the company concerning this matter.

Bed Bug News

Barbara Eckhardt ran across some new bed bug information that is very interesting. Scientists have found the bedbugs are comfortable finding safe haven near their own fecal and cuticle residues. Apparently histamines in these residues are attractants that can be synthesized and help in the fight to eradicate these pests. It sounds like these chemicals could be inexpensive to make.
